GRID KID WINS COOL RIDE TO SCHOOL

Allenton School pupil Cameron Radford didn't walk the 200m to school last Wednesday - he was driven by Suzuki Swift Sport Cup driver Chris Cox after winning the prize of a ride to school in a race car.

After entering early for the Suzuki Grid Kids Duathlon Series scheduled for Timaru on 22 January, Cameron was the lucky winner of the prize draw.

"Cameron was super excited. The grin hasn't left his face!" Cameron's mum Anna Radford said.

Suzuki Swift Sport Cup Driver Chris Cox was in Ashburton to help drive up the participation for the Suzuki Grid Kids Duathlon Series. All those who had entered the event early were in the draw to be taken to school in his car.

Cameron was the talk of the school and said he can't wait to see the racing in January. All entrants get free tickets to the motor racing plus two adult tickets.

The Timaru round will also feature Erin Simpson from The Erin Simpson Show, who will be there with a television crew to film participants for her 2012 series and offer encouragement to the grid kids.

The Duathlon distances are all achievable and suitable for the different age groups with 6-9 year-olds completing a 0.5km run and 2.8km bike and 10-13 year-olds completing a 1.0km run and 5.6km bike.

Entry is only \$25 for an individual, \$45 for a team (two people per team, one person runs and one person rides) or \$60 for a family (for three family members).
